Wine: Red
Grape: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
Classification: IGP - Veneto
Growing area: Colli Berici (Vicenza)
Cultivation system/vines per hectare: Guyot/4,000
Vineyard age: 25/35 years
Yield per hectare: 65 quintals
Harvest: Manual, last ten days of september-first ten days of october.

Cellar operations:

crushing-stemming, inoculation with selected yeast culture, automatically controlled fermentation in fermenting vats, with the grape marc moved daily and oxygenation of the must/wine. Ageing in concrete vats with movement on fine lees for at least six months.

Sensory profile:

ruby red with purplish highlights; notes of blueberry, blackcurrant, wild blackberry, and subtle spice. In the mouth, crisp, fruit-forward, and floral, with alluring sapidity and a long-lingering finish.

Serving suggestion:

soups, sausages, poultry, fresh cheeses.

A wine that is not too challenging but with all the personality of Cabernet, Idea is a remarkable balance on a fine line, in which each element is an expression of the variety and of the terroir. This is a wonderfully versatile wine, but its aristocratic credentials make it a pure pleasure to enjoy alone.
